Responding to a question during question hour, Minister for Petroleum and Natural Resources Ghulam Sarwar Khan said per liter prices of petrol and diesel in India are 144.20 and 129.65 rupees, while their rates in Pakistan are 92.83 and 106.57 rupees per liter.

He said the government is trying to adjust petroleum prices in line with the international market. To another question, the Minister also assured to pay salaries to daily wages and contract employees working in Sui Northern Gas Pipelines.
